I recently spoke to Bob Lang, Executive Director of Fr. Carr's Place 2B (<https://fathercarrs.org>). My mission was to contact him and hear his suggestions for a Council of Catholic Women Lenten Service Project benefitting Fr. Carr's. He suggested a project that would be a huge challenge for a small parish, namely to provide two sets of bunk beds for their facility in Oshkosh. These beds would have a twin bed on top and a full bed on the bottom (see examples below). As a first step, we are asking if anyone in the parish would have one to sell or donate to help with this project.
