We also welcome Gail Olson who will give a short presentation on mental health.

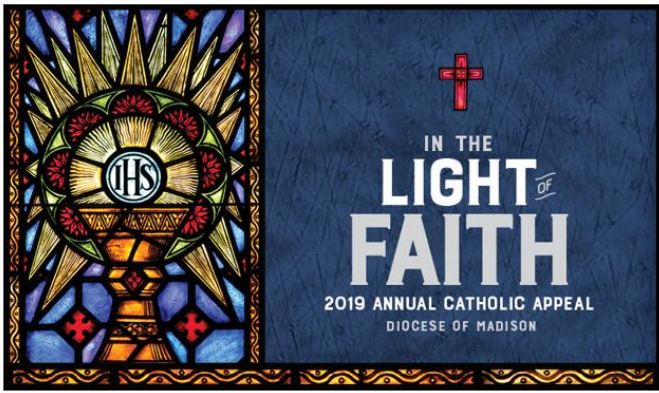
