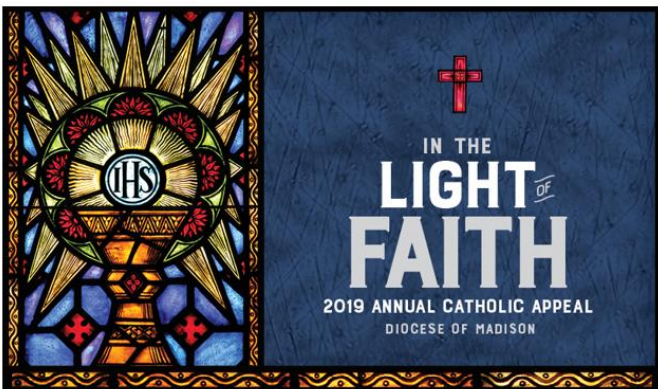
2019 Annual Catholic Appeal
