The CCW welcomes your support toward our fundraising efforts to purchase this twin over full bunk bed for Fr. Carr's Place 2B.

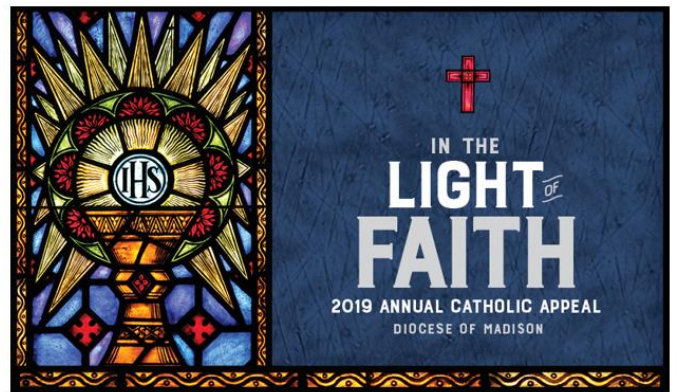
