## First Friday Anointing Mass

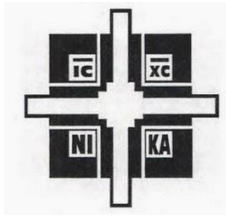

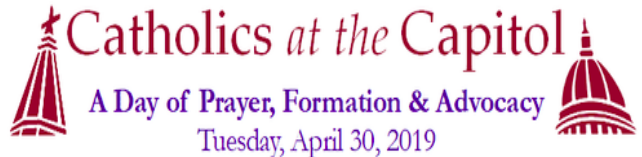
