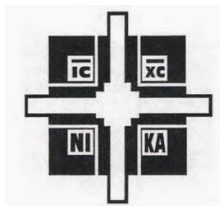
If there is enough interest, we will arrange for a motor coach to stop in Green Lake to pick people up. There is no cost for the event or the transportation.
